


### «Self-Portrait » of Frida Kahlo

### « Poppies » of Claude Monet



This masterpiece was made by Claude Monet in 1873. The painter revolutionized his time by founding the Impressionist movement. The painting represents the surrounding countryside of Argenteuil, home of Monet at that time. Indulge yourself by painting your field of poppies with beautiful spring colors and impressionist touches of your own.



## « Oh, Jeff... i love you, too but... » of Roy Lichtenstein

Oh, Jeff... I Love You, Too But... was made in 1964 by Roy Lichtenstein, one of the founding fathers of pop art in the United States in the 1950s - a trend that redefined all codes of art. The artist was inspired by popular advertising and comics. He only used primary colors and wrote messages on his paintings, inviting the viewer to create a unique universe. Lichtenstein is known for his creative spirit in both technique and style. This painting invites participants to this extraordinary world and seeks the expression of personal touches.





#### « Paris en automne » Leonid Afremov

In this theme of autumn, we put in the spotlight the work entitled "Paris in autumn" by Leonid Afremov, Belarusian painter of international fame. Leonid Afernov has an unmistakably impressionistic style. His paintings are colorful with a magical light.


#### Mediterranean Artists: From

### « Femme et deux biches » of Aly Ben Salem

Aly Ben Salem is a world famous Tunisian painter with a modern and timeless style. His unique universe evokes scenes of paradise and Eden. His work is composed of several units that repeat themselves. The principal unit is a woman represented in his own way: She has deer eyes, fine features and wears floral clothes. She is accompanied by deer represented on a colored background, decorated with stones, plants and air bubbles. Painting this piece of art is a perfect occasion to tickle your imagination!





#### « La confection du mechmoum » of Jellal Ben Abdallah



Jellal ben abdallah is one of the pioneers of the school of Tunis. This painting represents a still life. The drawing in this canvas is fine with a sense of details. The colors are soft and delicate. # **Œuvre commune**Abdelaziz Gorgi

A timeless work by the Tunisian painter Abdelaziz Gorgi which represents the artist's world "refreshing and cheerful, but in a cleverly cultivated disorder, an upside-down, a hallucinatory hustle and bustle of color and shapes" (Dorra Bouzid) .The work is divided into 6 small canvases (50cm / 50cm). The participants will have to reconstruct the whole like a puzzle to find harmony and end up with a work that is 1.5m / 1m in the end. Each participant will paint their own small canvas (which is part of the final artwork). Participants have fun reconstructing the puzzle, before starting to paint. They consult each other for each part, for each color of the work, teamwork with a beautiful, fun and friendly atmosphere.
